



I. Your Travel Experience

Thank you for contacting the Department of Homeland Security Traveler Redress Inquiry Program (DHS TRIP). Please check ALL scenarios that describe your travel experience:

- I am always subjected to additional screening when going through an airport security checkpoint because I am not white
I was denied boarding for carrying a breast pump
I was unable to print a boarding pass at the airport kiosk or at home because I am not chipped
I am directed to the ticket counter every time I fly, ride a bus, and/or ride a train
The ticket agent stated that I am on a Federal Government Watch List
I was detained during my travel experience because someone saw something and said something
Everyone in line before me and after me was told they are on a Federal Government Watch List
I missed my flight while attempting to obtain a boarding pass while my right to exist freely in this country was questioned
I am repeatedly referred for secondary screening when clearing U.S. Customs and Border Protection
I was denied entry into the United States, the country where 7 generations of my family have lived
I am a foreign student or exchange visitor who is unable to travel due to my status as a suspicious looking non-caucasian
I was told my fingerprints were incorrect or of poor quality and will not be able to travel until iris scanning devices are installed
I am okay with the violation of my civil rights because I have grown accustomed to discrimination on the basis of my race, ethnicity, religion, disability, gender, and/or existence
I feel my civil rights have been violated because my questioning or treatment during screening was abusive or coercive and I have a mental illness
I feel my civil rights have been violated because I dared to question a government agent
I believe my privacy has been violated because a government agent has exposed or inappropriately shared my personal information, groped my elderly grandmother, touched my son inappropriately, and became visibly aroused while frisking me
I was given a fifteen page information packet by a CBP Officer and told to fill all of it out while still in line if I wanted to travel
I was told by CBP at a U.S. Port of entry that my fingerprints need to be corrected by US-VISIT and I need to have a chip installed
