Her stories, essays, and poetry have appeared in print and online at *The Paris Review*, *The Missouri Review*, *McSweeney's*, *DIAGRAM*, *StoryQuarterly*, *Huffington Post*, *New World Writing*, *Gargoyle Magazine*, and *Redivider*, among other publications. Her intermedia has exhibited in New York, DC, Baltimore and Florence, Italy. She has won prizes and fellowships from Johns Hopkins, Aspen Writers Foundation, VCCA and Whidbey Writers and has been nominated for the Pen/Hemingway, Pen Emerging Writers, The &NOW Award, Lorian Hemingway, and multiple times for the Pushcart award. Rae earned a Masters in Writing from Hopkins where she continues to teach creative writing and is founding editor of *The Doctor T. J. Eckleburg Review*. She also teaches and lectures in the International Writing Program at The University of Iowa and The Eckleburg Workshops. She is represented by Jennifer Carlson with Dunow, Carlson & Lerner Literary Agency.
